COVID-19 related information

Have you been vaccinated yet?

Keep your certificate of vaccination carefully.

After vaccination, the certificate of vaccination will be issued at the venue. The sticker will be put on the certificate of vaccination at the bottom of the vaccination ticket, showing the vaccine that was given.



You may need your certificate of vaccination for restaurant visits, events, travel, hospital visits, etc. Please keep it carefully.



You can still get vaccinated.

Some medical institutions are still accepting appointments. Vaccinations in the city are being provided on a reduced scale, so please make an appointment as soon as possible if you wish to be vaccinated.

Vaccinations make you harder to get infected, and even if you get infected, it is more effective in preventing serious disease.




Vaccination Status

As of October 17, 91,367 people in the city have completed the first shot of vaccination (vaccination rate: 69.63%), and 72,665 people have completed the second shot (vaccination rate: 55.38%).

Some people have already made appointments and will be vaccinated. However, at present, by age group, the vaccination rate for people over 65 years old is over 90%, but as the age group gets younger, the vaccination rate becomes lower.

The vaccination rate is expected to exceed 70% citywide in mid-November, when people who have appointments complete their vaccinations.



Number of infected people

As of October 17, the number of COVID-19 infected people in the city was 684.

During this period, there have been five waves of outbreaks nationwide. In the fifth wave, from July to September, mutated strains such as the highly infectious delta strain caused an explosion of infection in many areas of the country.

The spread of the infection has progressed at an unprecedented speed in the city, and on August 29, the number of newly infected people reached 37, the highest number in the city. Since October 2, the number of newly infected people has decreased rapidly, but it is important for each person to continue infection prevention measures in order to minimize the spread of infection in the sixth wave.

Hurting your children is abuse.

Discipline is the act of repeatedly teaching children to distinguish between "what they are allowed to do" and "what they are not allowed to do" in society. Abuse is when a children feel unbearable pain. Even if you think it is for the sake of your children, if you damage their minds or bodies through over-education or strict discipline, it is abuse.

Children whose minds and bodies have been damaged by abuse could be traumatized by the experience, and

- They may not listen calmly.
- They may not keep their promises.
- They may not focus on one thing.
- They may not be patient.
- They may not express their emotions well.
- They may not act in groups, etc.

It is said to have a negative impact on growth and development.

If you suspect abuse, consult with us.



Even if you are not sure if it is abuse or not, it is okay. If you have any concerns about child care or family relations, please consult with the Family Child Guidance Room (*Katei jido sodan shitsu*) or Child Guidance Center (*Jido sodan jo*).

If you are late in paying, you may be charged a late fee.

In addition, if you fail to pay without any reason and do not contact or consult with us even after we give you a notice, you may be subject to seizure of property or other punishment.



If you are late for payment, please consult with us.

For those who are temporarily unable to pay taxes, tax payment may be postponed.

If you have any reason for not being able to pay by the due date, please consult with us in advance.

Yasashii Nihongo (Easy Japanese)

Easy Japanese is a Japanese that is rephrased in a way that is easy to understand for foreigners, children, the elderly, and people with disabilities.



Simply and Boldly

Even if the nuance is slightly different, say something boldly with simple words based on "です (*desu*)" and "ます (*masu*)".

[Example]

- When you want someone to do something, use "してください (*shite kudasai*)".
- When you can do something, use "することができます (*surukotoga dekimasu*)".
- When someone did something to you, use the expression "〇〇が□□をした (〇〇 *ga* □□ *wo shita*)".
- Try to not using idioms.

雨が 降っている時は 通ることが できません。 *Ame ga futteiru toki wa torukoto ga dekimasen.*

02 I was praised by my teacher.


