Notice Special Cash Payout for Low Income Households with Children

To support the livelihood of low-income and child-rearing households affected by COVID-19, the "Special Cash Payout for Low Income Households with Children" will be provided.

The amount of the benefit is 50,000 yen per child.

Eligibility

Single-parent households

- ①Those who have received the Child Support Allowance (jido fuyo teate) for April 2022.
- ②Those who have not received the Child Support Allowance for April 2022 because they have been receiving public pensions etc.
- ③Those whose household finances have suddenly changed and whose income has become the same level as that of the Child Support Allowance recipients.

Low-income households with children (*excluding single-parent households)

- (4) Those who have received the Child Allowance (*jido teate*) or the Special Child Support Allowance(*tokubetsu jido fuyo teate*) for April 2022 and are exempt from resident tax (per capital basis) for FY2022.
- ⑤Caregivers of children up to 18 years old (children with disabilities up to 20 years old) and who meet one of the following conditions.
 - (1) Those who are exempt from resident tax (per capital basis) for FY2022
 - (2) Those whose household finances have suddenly changed due to COVID-19 and whose income has become the same level as that of (1)

Application Please apply at the Child Future Division counter by February 28, 2023 (Tue).

Others If you meet 1 or 4, you are not required to apply.

Information on Seniors, Health, Medical Care, Nursing Care, and Disabilities

Be careful of heat stroke.

Hot summer season is coming soon. People lose appetite and strength in hot weather and are more likely to get heat stroke.

Due to self-quarantine during COVID-19 pandemic, people are going out less, losing strength and becoming more sensitive to the vulnerable to heat.

Let's prevent heat stroke while taking measures against infections disease.

Key Points to Prevent Heat Stroke

1 Drink water frequently.

- · When wearing a face mask, it is hard to feel thirsty and more likely to run out of water.
- Even if you are not sweating or thirsty, drink 1.2 liters of water per day.
- If you sweat a lot, it is also necessary to replenish salt.



2 Avoid the heat with clothing and air conditioners.

- Wear clothing made of airy and easy-to-dry materials. When going outside, avoid direct sunlight by wearing a hat or using a parasol.
- Even indoors, it is possible to get heat stroke, so use air conditioners and fans to regulate temperature and ventilate frequently.
- The recommended room temperature is below 28°C and humidity is bwlow 70%.



3 Build your body to withstand the heat.

- Eat well-balanced meals 3 times a day, exercise moderately, and get enough sleep.
- If you are outdoors and can keep a sufficient distance (2m or more) from people, remove your face mask.

4 Manage your health every day.

• Check your health, such as taking your temperature every morning. If you feel unwell, please take a rest and take care of yourself first.




