

How to Receive Medical Expense Subsidies

When you visit a medical institution, please show your insurance card and "子ども医療費受給者証 (Child Medical Expense Beneficiary Certificate)".

Co-payment for **Visiting a doctor**: 500 yen per visit (up to 4 visits per month)

Co-payment for **Hospitalizations**: none (except for extra charge for a room)

Be prepared for infections.

While the number of COVID-19 cases continues to rise to a high level, the season for seasonal influenza is spreading. When influenza and COVID-19 spread simultaneously and medical facilities are overwhelmed, you may not be able to see a doctor even if you have a fever or other symptoms.

Stockpile "Simultaneous Test Kits".

As a general rule, people infected with COVID-19 who are asymptomatic or mildly ill will be recuperated at home. However, if you are infected with influenza, you need to see a doctor and take medication. In case of infection with COVID-19 and influenza, you should be prepared with "Simultaneous Test Kits".

You can purchase them at pharmacies or online.

Please choose one that is labeled "第1類医薬品 (*Dai-1rui iyakuhin*)" or "体外診断用医薬品 (*Taigai Shindanyo iyakuhin*)."
 Test kits approved as pharmaceutical products can be found on the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare's website.



If you use a test kit and find that you are infected...

- **Infected with both COVID-19 and influenza**
 → Consult your family doctor or a medical institution.
- **Only infected with COVID-19**
 → Those over 65 years old, with underlying medical conditions, or who are pregnant should consult their family doctor or the Shizuoka Prefecture Consultation Center for Fever, etc.
 → Others should recuperate at home. (If symptoms worsen, consult your family doctor or the Shizuoka Prefecture Consultation Center for Fever, etc.).
- **Only infected with influenza**
 → Consult your family doctor or a medical institution.

Dear Parents and Guardians

If a child attending an elementary school, junior high school, nursery school, kindergarten, or certified child care center is infected with COVID-19 and does not see a doctor but recuperates at home, please take the following steps.

- ① Contact the school.
- ② Submit the certificate* on the first day a child returns to school after the recuperation period ended.

*Even a child does not see a doctor, he/she can attend school if the certificate is signed by a parent/guardian.

How to dispose of stove/fan heater

If there is any kerosene left inside, it may cause a fire, so please dispose of it in the following ways.

- ① Remove the batteries from the main unit.
- ② Drain all kerosene from the main unit and kerosene tank.
- ③ Separate the kerosene tank from the main unit, turn them upside down, and dispose of them on a Non Combustible Garbage collection day.



*If there is any kerosene or liquid left inside, it cannot be collected.


