Notice Exemption from National Pension Insurance premiums for the period before and after childbirth

National Pension Insurance premiums will be exempted for 4 months from the expected date of delivery , or from the month before the date of childbirth.

In the case of multiple pregnancies (twins, etc.), it will be exempted for 6 months from the expected date of delivery, or from 3 months before the date of childbirth.

Eligibility National Pension System Category 1 insured persons whose date of childbirth is on or after February 1, 2019. (Covered from National Pension Insurance premiums for April 2019)

Application From 6 months before the expected date of delivery, please come to the counter or by mail. * After childbirth, you can submit a notification at any time.

What to bring

- "Boshi Kenko Techo" (mother and child health handbook) *For confirming the expected date of delivery
- A Proof of "Basic Pension Number" or "My Number (individual number)"
- ID (My Number Card, driver's license, resident card, etc.)

Others Childbirth is defined as a birth of 85 days (4 months) gestation or more including stillbirths, miscarriages, and premature births.

Notice Current Status Report for Child Allowance (jido teate)

If there is no change in the child's care status, it is no longer necessary to submit a current status report. Those who are required to submit the report will receive it by mail in mid-June, and it must be submitted by June 30 (Mon).

Procedures are required in the following cases:

- When the recipient moves out of the city
- When the recipient and the child have different addresses
- When the recipient becomes a civil servant

Notice Medical Expense Subsidies for single-parent households, etc.

When you receive a medical treatment covered by insurance, we will subsidize the full amount of your copayment.

Eligibility Households that meet one of the following conditions and whose income during 2024 is not subject to income tax.

①Parents from single-parent households and who support children under 20 years old, and their children②Children under 20 years old who have no parents

③Children under 20 years old whose father or mother have severe disabilities or who are unable to receive support due to their prolonged detention or disappearance



Heat Stroke Prevention

Heat stroke is caused by an imbalance of water and salt in the body, which prevents the body from functioning properly to regulate body temperature, resulting in heat buildup in the body. Severe cases can lead to loss of life. In recent years, due to the effects of global warming, the number of people suffering from heat stroke has been increasing due to the continuous heat wave and midsummer days nationwide since early May.

In addition, the number of emergency medical care patients and fatalities have increased rapidly during the hot and humid period at the end of the rainy season when temperatures rise.

It is important to prevent heat stroke on a daily basis, rather than thinking, "I can handle this heat," or "I am OK.

Before becoming really hot

When the body is not accustomed to the heat and the temperature suddenly rises, the body cannot sweat well, and the risk of heat stroke increases.

Please make sure to build a body that can withstand the heat from now.

-Make a habit of sweating through moderate exercise such as walking and stretching.

-Use bedding with good breathability and absorbency, and air conditioning to create a comfortable sleeping environment.

-Eat three well-balanced meals a day.

Environments Prone to Heat Stroke

Heat stroke is more likely to occur in places with bad ventilation, strong sunlight, and high temperatures and humidity. During outdoor work that is exposed to direct sunlight for long period of time, or sports and other strenuous activities, the body temperature tends to rise easily, so be sure to pay attention to the temperature and humidity.

Turning on the air conditioner will not lower the room temperature immediately. It is important to ventilate the room when you get home.

A closed car interior can cause temperatures to rise rapidly in a short period of time, which can lead to fatal accidents.

Do not leave children alone in the car.

People who need special attention

The elderly, who have a weak sense of temperature, and children, who cannot regulate their body temperature well and are easily affected by the reflection of light from the ground, should be especially careful.

Even normally healthy people cannot regulate their body temperature as usual when they are sick due to lack of sleep or tiredness, or when their body fluids are low due to hangover or diarrhea.

People with disabilities may not be able to communicate symptoms on their own, so it is important for those around them to be considerate.

Measures to prevent from heat

Z Take water frequently, even if you are not thirsty, drinking 1 glass of water per hour, 1.2 liters per day

- ☑ Cool your body with cooling products such as ice packs or cooling sheets
- ☑ Wear quick-drying and breathable clothes
- When indoors, use air conditioners, fans, and other cooling appliances to keep the room temperature at an appropriate level (26-28°C) and avoid direct sunlight by using shading curtains or blinds.
- I When outside, use a parasol or hat, and take frequent breaks under shade trees or in other places where you can avoid the sun.







Take a rest frequently

Heat stroke symptoms progress rapidly and can become severe. Before symptoms of heat stroke appear, such as dizziness, lightheadedness, facial flushing, and numbness in the hands and feet, please take a rest, move to a cool place, and drink plenty of water and take in salt.

The "Cooling Shelter," a shelter to escape the heat, will be open until October 22 (Wed).


